



Eight Effective Uses of SAM Learning

The most popular ways of using Three-wave Intervention

Classroom Intervention

1000s of activities of different types to set to your learners - either as whole groups or as **Wave 1 targeted Intervention**.

Independent Learning

Your learners can log in to SAM Learning **during study periods or at home** - and revise the topics they know they most need to focus on.

Subject Intervention

Create **Wave 2 groups** across classes within your teaching subject to target work (e.g. revision bundles) - and monitor impact.

Y11 Borderline

After Y11 Mocks or PPEs, create **Wave 2 groups** to target revision bundles at - and to monitor engagement with revision.

Internal Exclusion

Teachers can set work for learners who have been temporarily removed - either through a **Wave 2 group** set up by your intervention leader or as individuals through **Wave 3**.

Remember - **10 hours** or more work on SAM Learning has been shown to boost grades!

Off-Campus Learners

Set work for learners who cannot make it into school every day - and review their progress (including how many hours of work they do) - use **Wave 3**.

Y7 Numeracy and Literacy

Our **intervention** resources include activities designed to bring your underperforming Year 7 learners up to "Secondary Ready".

SEND Support

Identify your pupils with individual needs (**Wave 2 groups**) and set them a programme of work tailored just for them (**Wave 3 Task Setting**).
