RATIOS

A ratio is a way of comparing the relative sizes or amounts of two or more quantities.

Lime cordial Water

To make lime squash, dilute lime cordial with water in the ratio 1:5. This means that for every 1 measure of lime cordial you use, there are 5 measures of water. So it could be 1 litre of lime cordial and 5 litres of water. Or it could be 100ml of lime cordial and 500ml of water.

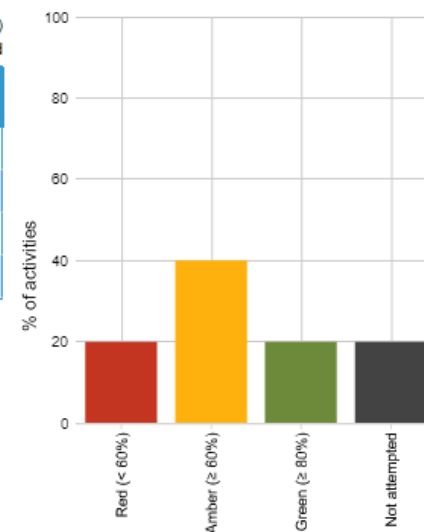
