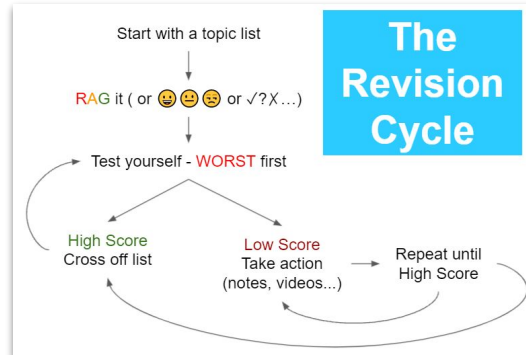

- Do a SAM Learning activity on that weak topic - start with a *Revise-type* activity to **check your knowledge**

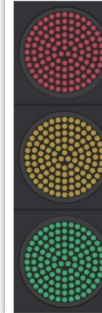
